What is an external CIT member?

All campuses identified as Academically Unacceptable (AU) are required by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) to appoint a Campus Intervention Team (CIT). The external CIT member assists the campus in the development, execution, and monitoring of a school improvement plan to meet the needs of the campus. The CIT provides resources, guidance, support, and leadership to help schools meet success in the state accountability system.
